

Supply Lists

General Primary School Supplies

- Backpacks: Students may carry any kind of backpack they choose (no character backpacks, please). Since primary students do not bring home textbooks every night, it need not be large. In fact, the larger ones, particularly the ones with wheels, are heavier than the contents and much more cumbersome to carry up and down stairs.
- Labels: Label your child's art box with his first and last name. Watercolors, scissors, and erasers can be marked with initials. No other items need to be labeled.
- Some supplies will be provided by the school, such as journals, homework folders, pencil sharpeners and whiteboards.
- Please bring your supplies on Meet the Teacher Day to avoid having so much to carry on the first day. The art box should be packed with unwrapped crayons, scissors, colored pencils and erasers. All other supplies will be collected as "community supplies".
- Art boxes should be no larger than size specified. Tables and cubbies are small! Please do not decorate boxes with sticker or other objects.
- Please do not send extra supplies that are not listed.

Junior Kindergarten

1st and 2nd Grade

Watercolor set: 16 or 24 colors (1st Grade only)
Prang preferred, Crayola acceptable

Colored Pencils: 24 pack of Crayola

Ruler: 12 inch wooden

Dry Erase Markers: thin tip; dark color (preferably black);

Erasers: 2 large pink

Grading Pens: 2 red (2nd Grade only)

Sock: for white board eraser

Index Cards: 1 pkg. blank 3 x 5 cards (1st Grade only)

Boys: 1 bottle of hand sanitizer and 1 roll of paper towels

Girls: 1 box of tissues and 1 container of disinfecting wipes

3rd Grade

Please label all items marked * with your student's name. All items marked "☺" will be collected as "community" supplies. Please do not bring larger quantities or extra supplies that aren't listed since our storage space is limited. It would help our first day of school to start more smoothly if you would bring all supplies (labeled!) to the Meet the Teacher Day. Thank You!

- Large back pack*
- A sturdy, 1 ½ inch, 3-ring binder (for all subjects)
This will be kept at home to store returned quizzes, tests and other assignments. It is the responsibility of the student (with parental aid!) to file all returned paper in this binder for future use.
- 8 dividers for use in the 3-ring binder
Labeled: Latin, Math, Literature, Language Arts, Classical, Christian, Astronomy, and American
- Flashcards: Addition & Multiplication (also kept at home; will be used regularly for HW)
- 3 spiral notebooks (70 pages, wide rule)
 - 1 RED, labeled Latin*
 - 1 YELLOW, labeled Math*
 - 1 GREEN, labeled Grammar*
- 2 pocket folders (with horizontal pockets):
 - 1 sturdy plastic, BLUE* (this will travel back & forth daily)
 - 1 any color/design/type* (this will stay at school in their desk)
- 1 supply box (small size 8"x5")*
(NO BIGGER please, desks are small!)
- 1 box (24 or more) #2 pencils sharpened, please☺
(NO MECHANICAL PENCILS)
- 2 red pens ☺
- 3 yellow highlighters ☺
- 2 large pink erasers
- Colored pencils (24 pack of Crayola)*, sharpened
- 12-inch, non-bendable ruler

4th Grade

Our first day of school will run more smoothly if you would bring all supplies to Meet the Teacher Day. If you can't come that day, bring them to the first day of class. Please bring *only* the necessary supplies to school. Other supplies will be provided by the school (e.g. planner).

**Label these items with your name.

Put these items in your desk:

- **2x spiral bound graph notebooks, 4x4 quad ruled
- **1x small pencil box (8"x5") to store supplies
- **1x spiral-bound, wide ruled, single subject notebook
- **1 sturdy 1" binder with insertable clear pockets on the outside (this will travel back and forth daily)
- 2 packages of loose leaf paper, wide ruled (one to be kept at home)
- 2x packages spiral-bound index cards

Put these items in your pencil box:

- **2x large pink erasers
- **1x quality handheld pencil sharpener
- 1x package (24 or more) no. 2 pencils (Have some sharpened for the first day!)
- 2x mechanical pencils (with lead replacement)
- 2x red ballpoint pens
- 2x yellow highlighters
- 1x sock/rag/small board eraser (for individual white boards)

Turn in to your teacher:

Keep at home:

- Flashcards: Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, and Division (will be used regularly for homework)
- 1x sturdy 2 inch binder (used to store quizzes, tests, and other assignments. Graded assignments will be sent home in the students' 1 inch binder. It is the responsibility of the students to file these graded assignments in their binder.)
- 8x dividers for 2 inch binder. (Label the tabs: Latin, Math, Literature, Language Arts, FMR, Geography, Christian Studies, Science.)

5th Grade

Please bring all supplies on Meet the Teacher Day.

- 3 1-1/2 inch white view binders-with insertable clear pockets on the outside
- One 2 inch binder with 7 pocket dividers labeled as follows: Math, Literature, Language Arts, American Studies, Classical Studies, Christian Studies, and Science
This binder will remain at home for the students' use in filing tests, handouts, etc. after we have finished them in class. These papers will come home with students in their "To be Filed" folder.
- 1 folder with pockets labeled as follows: The left pocket should be labeled "Homework." The right pocket should be labeled "To be Filed." This folder will travel between school and home. All homework should be placed in the "Homework" pocket and returned to school with the student. The "To be Filed" folder should be emptied each night and all papers filed in the binder at home for future reference if needed.

One red, labeled Grammar

Grades 7-12

This is not a complete list. Teachers will indicate any other required materials when school begins.

All students:

- Students will need 3 ring binders for their subjects.

Regardless of whether you have separate binders or combined binders, each subject should have a pocket and dividers for 3 sections.

- pens (red, blue, and black)
- pencils and erasers
- highlighters
- loose leaf college ruled notebook paper
- clear plastic ruler (non-bendable) with metric scale
- calculator
- box of Kleenex

7th Grade:

- Composition notebook (non-spiral)
- Binder with dividers for Literature, Grammar, Composition, and Homework.
- Pre-Algebra
 - ✓ **SM:** 2" 3-ring binder with five dividers with tabs (the kind of dividers that do not have pockets). The divider tabs should be labeled: Notes; Tests and Quizzes; Homework; Warm-ups; Miscellaneous.
 - ✓ **CHBC:** 2" 3-ring binder with five dividers with tabs (the kind of dividers that do not have pockets). Students will label in class.
 - ✓ ¼-inch graph paper
 - ✓ whiteboard markers (your color of choice)
 - ✓ protractor
 - ✓ ruler (6" would be fine with both English and metric scales)

8th Grade:

- Composition notebook (non-spiral)
- Binder with dividers for Literature, Grammar, Composition, and Homework.
- 1" 3-ringed binder, 4 dividers
- 2 blue pens
- 1 highlighter
- 2 mechanical pencils,
- 6" standard metric ruler

- small stapler

9-12th Grade:

Precalculus:

- 1" 3-ringed binder, 4 dividers
- 2 blue pens

- 2 mechanical pencils
- 6" standard metric ruler
- 2 pkgs. engineering paper
- small stapler
- compass
- protractor

Calculators:

Graphing calculators are optional for science classes, Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry. They are required for Precalculus and Calculus. The TI 82-89 are all sufficient for High School use. TI-Nspires are not as durable and are not recommended. Borrow or buy used.
