- 1. Thursday, December 13<sup>th</sup> Primary School Christmas Cantata, CHBC Sanctuary, 8:15AM
  - This is a regular school day for all students.
  - ❖ Primary (K-2) students should wear performance uniforms.
  - ❖ Performance begins at 8:15
- 2. Friday, December 14<sup>th</sup> Grammar School Christmas Cantata, CHBC Sanctuary, 4:30PM
  - This is a regular school day for all students.
  - $3^{rd} 6^{th}$  grade students should wear **performance uniforms**.
  - ❖ Please pack a snack for your student to eat in their classroom after school.
  - ❖ Students will be escorted to the chapel at 2:45PM for rehearsal.
  - ❖ Performance begins at **4:30PM** in the sanctuary.
- 3. Thursday, December 20<sup>th</sup> is a **non-uniform day!** 
  - ❖ All students will be dismissed at noon.
  - Children may dress casually and comfortably. Students may wear jeans. Please no flip-flops, tank tops, sweatpants, t-shirts with inappropriate graphics, or hats.

  - ❖ K-6th 'Twas the Night Right Before Christmas Book Exchange

Each student should bring a wrapped book, appropriate for the culture of HLS, for a student in his or her age group. #### Class Christmas Parties

- o  $1^{st}$   $2^{nd}$  grade students will have their book exchange in the gym from 10:30-10:45 and parties in the classroom from 10:50-11:55.
- o  $3^{rd} 6^{th}$  grade students will have the book exchange in the gym from 10:45 11:05 and then "lunch goodies" in their classrooms from 11:10 11:55.
- o **Kindergarten students** will have their book exchange and parties in their classroom from 11:00-11:55.

Please remember that HLS strives for a simple celebration that focuses on the joy of the season, not on the commercial and material aspects. We ask that you not send in goodie-bags or individual gifts for your child's classmates. As stated in the Parent Handbook, "Holiday celebrations should focus on the significance of the holiday and our sense of community and family. Celebrations should be age-appropriate and classy without excessive commercialization."
