- 1. Thursday, December 13th Primary School Christmas Cantata, CHBC Sanctuary, 8:15AM
 - This is a regular school day for all students.
 - ❖ Primary (K-2) students should wear performance uniforms.
 - ❖ Performance begins at 8:15
 - ❖ We ask families to arrive at 7:45 A.M. and meet teachers in the sanctuary entry way off Birchwood Ave. After the cantata, please pick up your students in the entry way and transport them to the IN campus for the rest of the school day.
