Artwork should be inspired from a scene, character, or theme found in one of the books listed below in the students' respective grade level. Please include with your Submission Form a statement from the student that summarizes their inspiration.

- First and Second Grade: Make Way for Ducklings, The Little House, Stone Soup, Beatrix Potter books, Little House in the Big Woods
- Third and Fourth Grade: Farmer Boy, Charlotte's Web, The Lion, the Witch, and the Wardrobe, Lassie Come-Home, The Moffats, Heidi
- Fifth and Sixth Grade: King Arthur and His Knights of the Round Table, Adam of the Road, Adventure of Robin Hood, The Bronze Bow, Anne of Green Gables, The Trojan War
- Seventh and Eight Grade: Wind in the Willows, Treasure Island, Adventures of Tom Sawyer, Beowulf the Warrior, Romeo and Juliet, Sir Gawain and the Green Knight
- High School: A Tale of Two Cities, Scarlet Letter, Henry V
