### All Students

- Four 3-ring solid color binders. Specific requirements noted below.
- Pens (red, blue, and black)
- Pencils and erasers
- Highlighters
- Colored Pencils (12-24)
- Loose leaf college ruled notebook paper- 3 packages
- Clear plastic ruler with metric scale
- Protractor
- 12 Thin Black Dry erase markers
- Dry erase eraser
- Boys – 2 Kleenex (bring to office)
- Girls – 2 Clorox Wipes (bring to office)
- 7th-12th grades require a graphing calculator.
  - For graphing calculators, the TI 83-84 are acceptable.
  - Standardized Testing does not allow TI 89 or TI 92.
